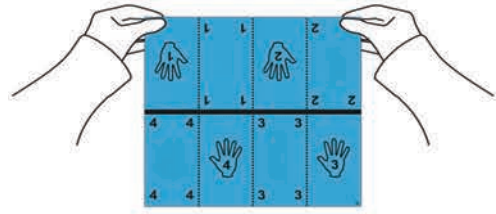
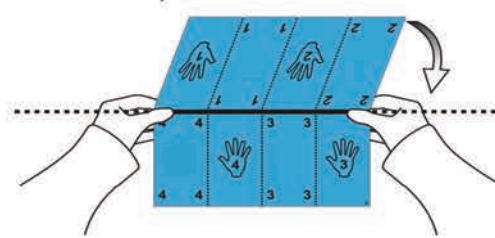




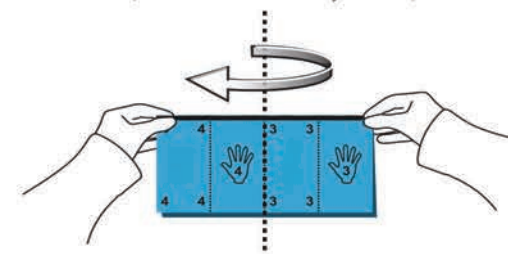
1 Hold the cloth with the print facing you (no. 3 and no. 4 at the bottom).



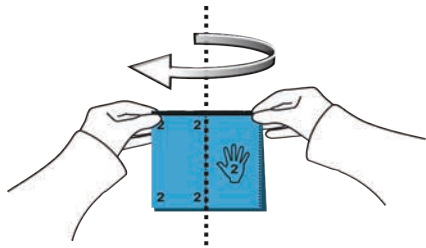
2 Hold the cloth, placing your thumbs on the folding line. Fold the section above the line, from front to back.



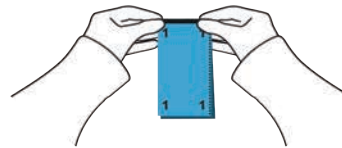
3 Then fold the cloth again from left to right (no. 3 on no. 4).



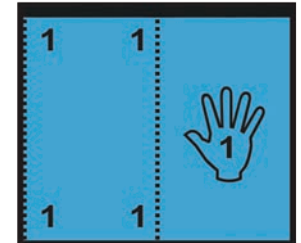
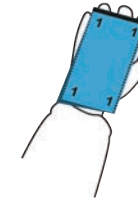
4 Then fold it again from right to left.



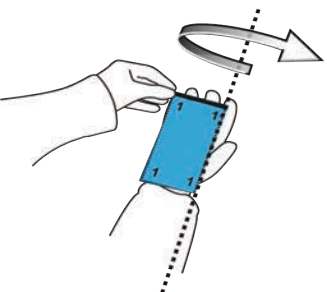
5 Work surface 1 is now visible.



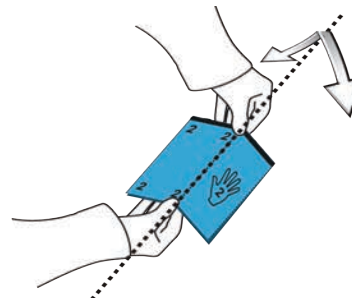
6 Place the palm of your hand on the back of hand no. 1. You can now clean with the first work surface.



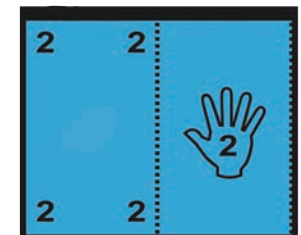
7 After soiling work surface no. 1 of the cloth, unfold it from left to right.



8 Fold the cloth backwards along the dotted line. Work surface no. 2 is now visible.

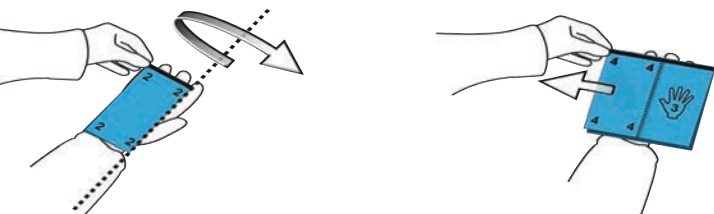


9 Place the palm of your hand on hand no. 2. You can now clean with the second work surface.

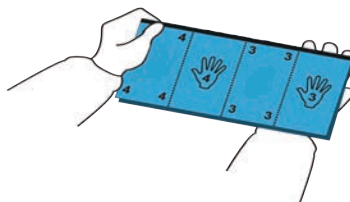




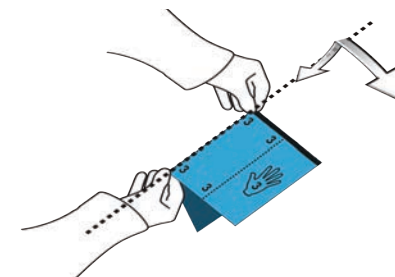
10 After soiling work surface no. 2 of the cloth, unfold the cloth twice. One side from left to right and one side from right to left.



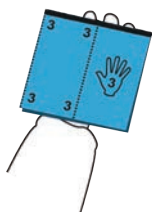
11 Surfaces no. 3 and no. 4 are now visible.



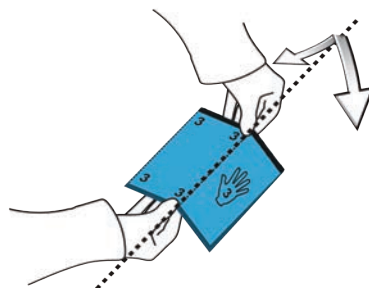
12 Fold the cloth backwards along the dotted line.



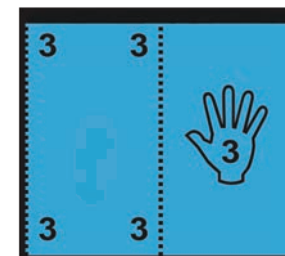
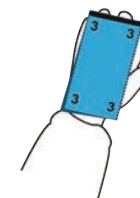
13 Place the cloth on the palm of your hand with surface no. 3 facing up.



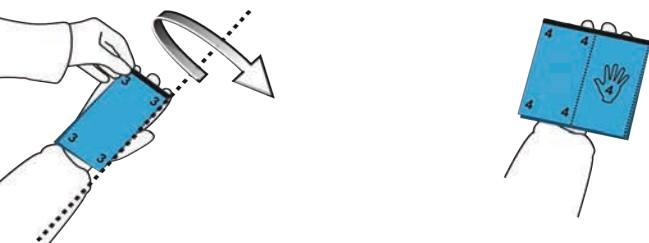
14 Fold the cloth backwards along the dotted line.



15 Place the palm of your hand on hand no. 3. You can now clean with the third work surface.



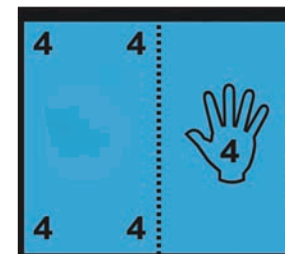
16 After soiling work surface no. 3 of the cloth, unfold the cloth so work surface no. 4 becomes visible.



17 Fold the cloth backwards along the dotted line. Work surface 4 is now visible.



18 Place the palm of your hand on hand no. 4. You can now clean with the fourth work surface.



19 Now use the other side of the cloth and repeat these steps. This enables you to use 8 sides of 1 cloth.
